## Bruised but Saved

Sealy, Texas recently experienced an extreme weather event known as a microburst. Most of us living here have not heard of this type of storm before, but soon learned how devastating it can be. It's estimated that 75 -100 homes were destroyed, countless cars totaled and many businesses experienced losses too.

My experience had a profound effect on me. It has me examining my faith and myself.

A few minutes before 7 pm on Tuesday, May 22, I was walking towards Sealy High School to attend Senior Awards Night. I was excited! My daughter, Elise was to receive her National Honor Society Collar, her Distinguished Graduate and Honor Graduate cords and hopefully, college scholarships.

It had rained a little on my way to the high school, so when I exited the car, I grabbed an umbrella and headed towards to auditorium. About 10 yards from the building, the sky burst open with tons of hail forcefully falling earthwards. I was astounded and be-

gan running towards the building. The door that was right in front of me was locked. I knew that I would have to make my way to the side door. I tried to raise my umbrella, but it immediately collapsed from the force of the falling hail. I tried to walk alongside the building, but made little headway against the winds (which we later found out were 80 - 100 miles an hour).

My mind was reeling with ideas on what to do. I decided that I must be in the midst of a tornado, so I should lie down. My body, being assaulted by the hail being flung at me at 80 miles an hour, convinced me that was not a good idea. I decided to loop my arms through the door handles and hang on. As I stood there, I leaned as close to the building as I could and crouched, trying to make myself a smaller target.

This is when I thought I finally understood the stoning in the Bible. Before that I had sometimes wondered how stoning actually killed someone. I wondered how long the storm would last and if I would survive.

After three minutes in the storm, someone noticed that I was trapped outside. She tried to open the door, but the wind was too strong. She looked at me and I could see that she was saying something, and then walked away. Was my savior leaving me? She returned with help - it took three people pushing and me pulling to open the door wide enough for me to enter the building.

My daughter ran to meet me. People took my things, gave me a dry shirt,

repeatedly asked if I was okay. The first thing I thought of was that my son was home alone, so I had my daughter call him, when he didn't answer, I called him and found out he was okay.

I was escorted to the cafeteria where there was more light and less people and other injured folks. They tried to get me to sit down, but I had to pace and talk to

process what had occurred. It was then that it dawned on me that I had not once prayed or called on God for help. This worried me. So I said a quick prayer of thanksgiving and told God I would get back to him later.

Basically the right side of my body, particularly my arm, shoulder and head were a mass of welts and some bruising as already showing. I was more concerned about an elderly man who was bleeding and appeared to be in shock. Another family friend was there with bruising and another mom had injuries to her hand. These people were on the other side of the building under a portico which acted like a wind tunnel. I figured out that the area I thought to go towards to escape the hail was perhaps a more dangerous place.

After resting and talking to a lot of

people, I was able to come to peace with my experience. It was during my pacing and processing that I came up with this title "Bruised but Saved" – I told someone that if I wrote music, I would write a song of that title. I said it flippantly, but as I thought more about it, it defined my experience in this storm and throughout life.

I can't remember a time when I did not believe in God. I was raised as a Christian and though may have strayed away from organized religion a few times in my life, I have always believed in God's love for me.

My father suffered from major depression and our family suffered along with him. In some of his darkest hours, prayer is what kept him going. His childhood abuse, PTSD from military service, death of a child all bruised his

psyche, but not his faith. And I feel the same way. My father's illness, job difficulties, financial losses, personal battles with depression, have all bruised me along the way of life. But God has provided for my salvation through Jesus Christ and I am saved.

I worried that I had not prayed during the storm. But as a friend pointed out, God was with me. I was calm throughout the process, I as able to do what I needed to help me survive. I was bruised by the hail, but saved from the remainder of the storm.

For everyone going through storms in their life, I wish for you the peace of mind that only faith in God can provide. I pray for your salvation through your belief in Jesus Christ.

# Chocolate Brownie Cake

## Cake

- 1 box chocolate cake mix
- 1 box fudge brownie mix
- 4 eggs
- 1 1/4 cups water
- 1 cup oil

## Ganache

- 1 cup heavy whipping cream
- 1 lb (12 oz) semi-sweet chocolate morsels



## Instructions

- Heat oven to 350 degrees. Prepare a bundt pan with bakers' spray or use the butter/flour method.
- Combine first five ingredients in a large bowl and whisk for 2 minutes or until lumps are mostly gone.
- Pour batter into prepared bundt pan and bake for 50-55 minutes.
- When done baking, remove cake and allow to cool in pan for up to five minutes. Carefully turn cake out onto a cooling rack and cool for 30 minutes more.

## Ganache Instructions

- Place heavy whipping cream in a large microwave safe bowl and heat for about 2 minutes. You want the cream to be just boiling.
- Carefully pour chocolate morsels into cream--it may rise up and bubble and this is ok.
- Let sit for 5 minutes. Whisk the chocolate and cream until shiny and smooth, about 1 minute.
- Pour over cooled cake and serve.
